## **Improvement Initiatives Rationale**

Evaluation of school data (2017 year 3 NAPLAN data) shows that students are achieving high levels of growth across all capability levels and learning domains and that we are ensuring that each individual students is challenged and supported to achieve their personal best. We have continued work to do to fully align with FISO to collectively build the capacity of the school to deliver more effective teaching, improved learning and improved schooling outcomes. We lack sufficient data to confirm that we are providing a stimulating learning environment. This is an ongoing issue. Our main emphasis will be to use of a broad range of internal and external assessment measures and observations to gauge student achiement. Further targetted professional learning will be required in 2018-19 to embed effective formative assessment and student feedback. We will also continue to actively promote Glen Park Primary School as a small school alternative in the local area (including beyond our local catchment area)
